Youth Organization Education Sail Application Form

Gloucester City Sail's core mission is to provide local youth the opportunity to do science, learn history, and work on the Schooner North Wind while sailing on the Delaware River.

Annually, we are able to offer up to 10, highly subsidized, 2 hour sailing programs to local youth groups. While non-profits get priority, we offer the program to most area youth organizations that serve our community. The subsidy lowers the cost of these sails from the normal cost of \$950 to \$350.

The typical event leaves from either Freedom Pier in Gloucester City or Wiggins Marina in Camden, with an approximate 2 hour duration, sailing north past the Philadelphia skyline and the battleship USS NJ, and then return. During the trip we can offer a number of mini courses (we call them Ed Stations), as well as commentary about the sites we pass.

Our sailing times are constrained by the tides. Therefore, we will need for you to tell us a range of possible dates, days of the week, and time ranges that will work for you, and we will let you know what fits within our allowable tide windows.

We have the following requirements:

- The organization must provide for transportation to and from the point of embarkment/disembarkent. This is typically at Freedom Pier in Gloucester City, but other locations at times may be arranged.
- 2) Ages of youth from 8 18 years.
- 3) Each youth will need to have a parental/guardian permission slip to attend.
- 4) Number of youth 12 -21. Note: If you have a small group, we can try to combine you with another small group to satisfy the minimum number requirement.
- 5) We require 1 adult group member per 7-10 youth
- 6) We encourage the youth to bring a water bottle, and snacks
- 7) Safety is our first concern. If the Captain cancels the trip due to inclement weather, we will offer to reschedule at a later date.
